1. A description of the target learner population/context targeted for your lesson: EIL Students
2. Principles that will be taught: Skill: Reading Principle: Inferencing
3. Learning outcome / clearly stated objectives: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Students will able to accurately infer and summarize information from a reading passage
4. Materials needed to teach this lesson: <ul style="list-style-type: none">● PPT● Vocabulary lists● Use dictionary - longman● Kahoot● Reading passage of the secret of garden
5. Review / Warm-up (4 minutes) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Kahoot activity (Inferencing)
6. Overview (2 minutes) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Pre-reading the story of the secret of the garden.- Learn vocabulary words based on the reading.- Discuss what inferences that they gather and compare it with other groups- Summarize the reading passage.
7. Presentation of new information (4 minutes) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- What is inference ?- Learning reading strategy- Show how "what it says" (textual evidence) plus "what I know" (background knowledge) leads to "what it means" (inference). Provide a diagram.
8. Appropriate practice opportunities for the new information (5 minutes)

- Use the vocabulary lists and make inferences that are related.

9. Performance / main activity (25 minutes)

- Divide them into 3 groups
- Watch a trailer of Secret Garden
- Read the story of the secret garden and answer the questions.
- Compare and summarize all the answers.

10. How will you evaluate the practice of the new information (e.g., assessment of learning outcome)? AND what is your evaluation of the lesson? What went well and what could have gone better? (5 minutes)

- Call a representative of each group to come to the front and tell them what he/she infers from the reading.

11. How will you summarize the new information taught in this lesson?

- Ask them how helpful it is to learn making inference for reading skill.
- Ask them how they will use inferences when reading.
